Dear Parents/Carers

Year 5 visit to the British Museum on Wednesday 26th June 2019

There will be an educational visit for Year 5 to the British Museum on Wednesday 26th June 2019. This trip is linked to the history curriculum looking at the Ancient Greeks. A Greek Myths workshop has been booked and the children will explore Greek artefacts in the Museum. We shall be leaving school at **8.15am sharp** and hope to return by approximately **4.00pm**. Children will need to be in school promptly **at 8.00am** ready to depart at 8.15am. We will be unable to wait if your child arrives late. A parentmail text message will be sent out to let parents/carers know that the children have arrived at the Museum. Should there be a delay on the return journey a further text message will be sent.

School uniform must be worn for this trip and as an extra security measure children will wear high visibility jackets with the school name on the back. Children will not need to bring money or a camera on this trip.

Please provide your child with a packed lunch for the day in a carrier bag which will be thrown away and non-fizzy drinks in cartons or plastic bottles (not cans or glass containers).

Coaches have been booked with restraint harness belts to BSS specification to transport the children. A parental contribution of £10.00 will be required by Wednesday 1st May 2019. All parents should be set up with a sQuid account as this will be the only method of payment for this visit. Parents will be able to log onto sQuid from 3pm today to pay. Should you experience any problems with sQuid please call into the Junior School finance office for assistance. Please return your consent form to school as soon as possible.

I am sure that the day will be a very interesting and enjoyable one for the children and that they will have plenty to talk about upon their return.
